Four German UCI Continental Teams take part in Deutschland Tour

The teams for the Deutschland Tour 2023 have been selected. In addition to the 16 international teams from the WorldTour and the second division, four German UCI Continental teams have also received an invitation. The Deutschland Tour starts on August 23 in St. Wendel, Saarland, and runs over five days of racing to Bremen.

This year, the coveted invitation to Germany's most important cycling event was given to the teams Bike Aid, P&S Benotti, rad-net Oßwald and Saris Rouvy Sauerland Team. The Deutschland Tour is the only German stage race where the talents of domestic UCI Continental teams can compete with Tour de France teams.

Each of the 20 teams will nominate six riders in the coming weeks. This year's Tour will take place from August 23 to 27, covering 724 kilometers from Saarland to Bremen.
