World's best at the Deutschland Tour: Ten WorldTour teams at the start

Of the 20 teams competing in the Deutschland Tour on August 23 in St. Wendel, half are from the WorldTour. In addition to the only German elite team, Bora - hansgrohe, there are many international first division teams with German pros in the squad. Additionally at the start of Germany's most important cycling event are six teams from the second division as well as four German continental teams who will receive their invitations after the German Championships.

There is a good chance that cycling fans can once again look forward to the country's best riders. With Nils Politt, Maximilian Schachmann or the two-time stage winner of the Giro d'Italia, Nico Denz, Borahansgrohe would have exactly the right riders for the hilly sections in the team. The Deutschland Tour runs from August 23 to 27 from Saarland to Bremen. In the middle part of the five days of racing, many undulating kilometers characterize the route.

With UAE Emirates, the currently best team in the world has also announced itself for August. Deutschland Tour defending champion Adam Yates will be riding for the team, as well as Pascal Ackermann. The top sprinter has already won stages at the Deutschland Tour and the sprint finale in Bremen seems tailor-made for him. Bahrain Victorious was successful last year with a stage win and second overall. The team has two experts for the prologue with Nikias Arndt and Jasha Sütterlin.

There are also German riders in the ranks of Alpecin-Deceuninck, Ineos Grenadiers, Movistar Team, Soudal Quick-Step and Team DSM. Intermarché - Circus - Wanty around Georg Zimmermann traveled home with the white jersey of the best young rider in the past two years. The ambitious rider from Augsburg could also convince on this year's route. Also from the WorldTour at the start: Trek - Segafredo.

Riding second league but with top riders at the start, are the teams Lotto Dstny and Uno-X Pro Cycling, which in Caleb Ewan and Alexander Kristoff each have a stage winner from last year's Deutschland Tour in their ranks. Israel – PremierTech is making its third consecutive appearance, while TotalEnergies and the two Swiss teams Tudor Pro Cycling Team and Q36.5 Pro Cycling are making their debut at the Tour.
