

Bike Aid and Rembe | rad-net to compete in the Lidl Deutschland Tour 2025

The two German UCI Continental teams, Bike Aid and Rembe | rad-net, have secured their spots at the Lidl Deutschland Tour 2025. Germany's most prestigious stage race will this year take riders from Essen to Magdeburg. From 20 to 24 August, local talents will line up alongside international stars across five exciting days of racing.

With Bike Aid and Rembe | rad-net now confirmed, the line-up for the Lidl Deutschland Tour 2025 is complete. Alongside eleven UCI WorldTour teams and five UCI ProTeams, the two German Continental teams add local talent and energy to the race.

Rembe | rad-net heads into the race on a high: currently dominating the German Bundesliga and holding the entire podium, the team can expect strong support from fans – especially during the first three stages in North Rhine-Westphalia.

Bike Aid, meanwhile, continues to impress as the highest-ranked German Continental team in the UCI standings. Following a podium finish at last weekend's German National Championships, they now look to complete a hat-trick at the Lidl Deutschland Tour, having received a wildcard invitation for the third consecutive year.
